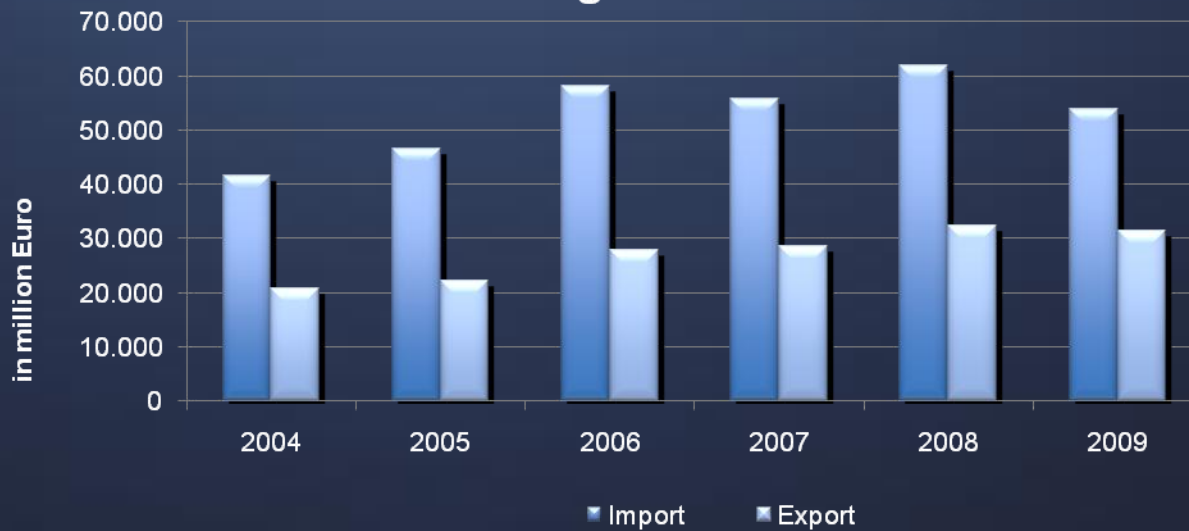

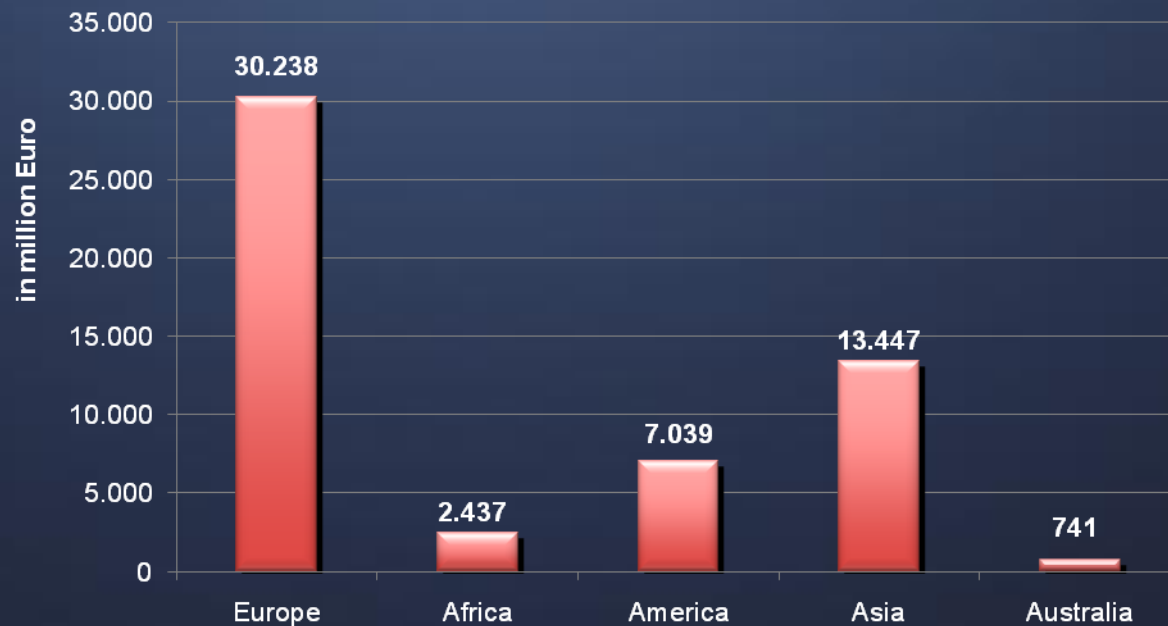
Hamburg is Germany's "Gateway to the World". Germany's preeminent centre of foreign trade and major hub for trade with the Baltic Sea region.

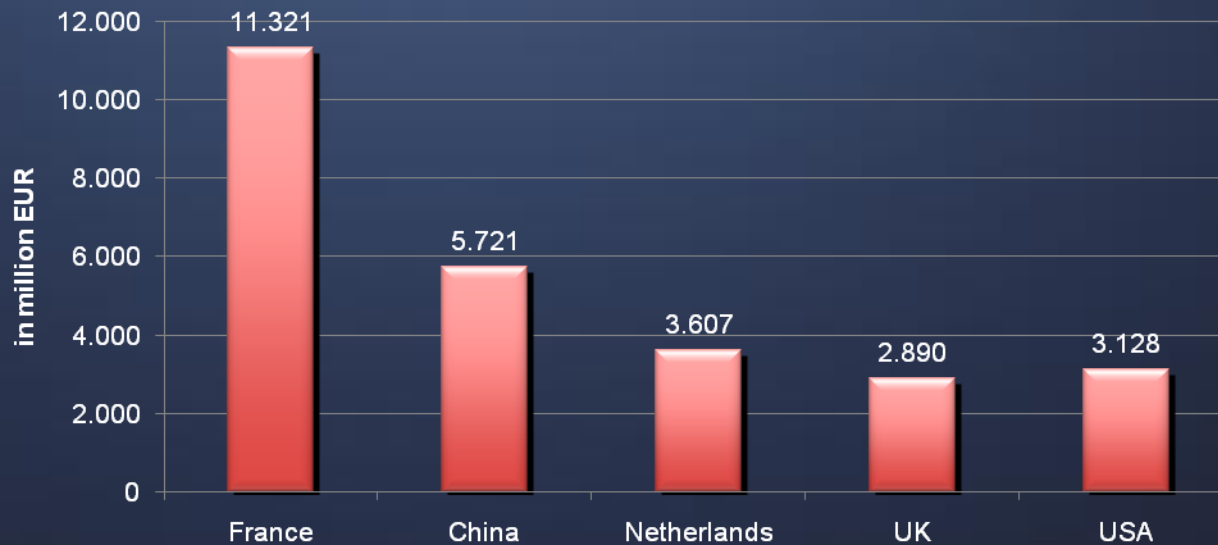

State of Hamburg, imports in 2009 (by continents)



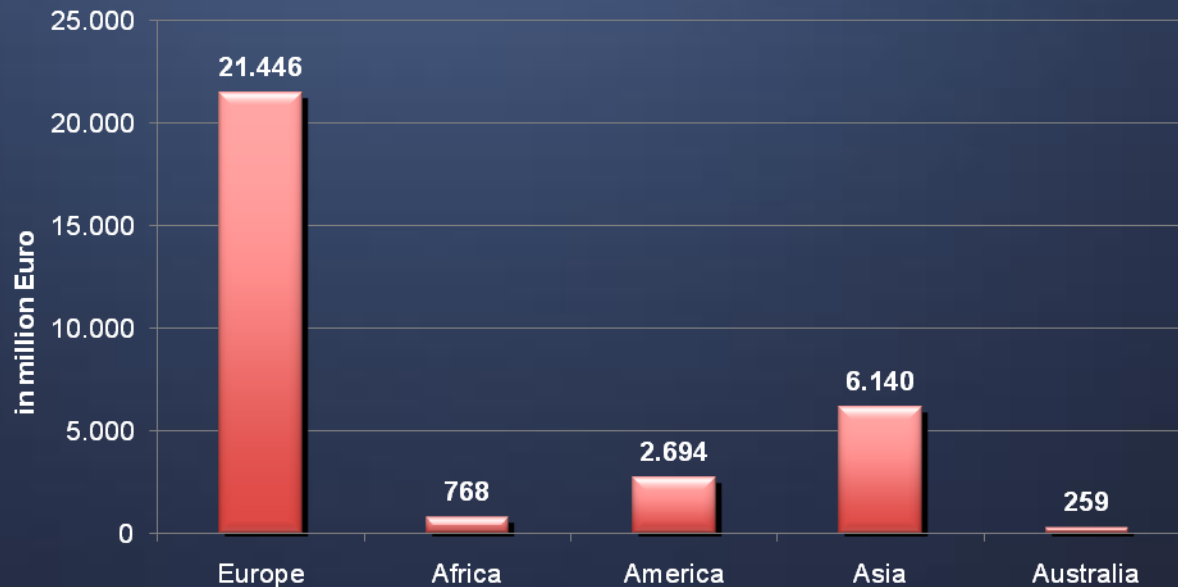

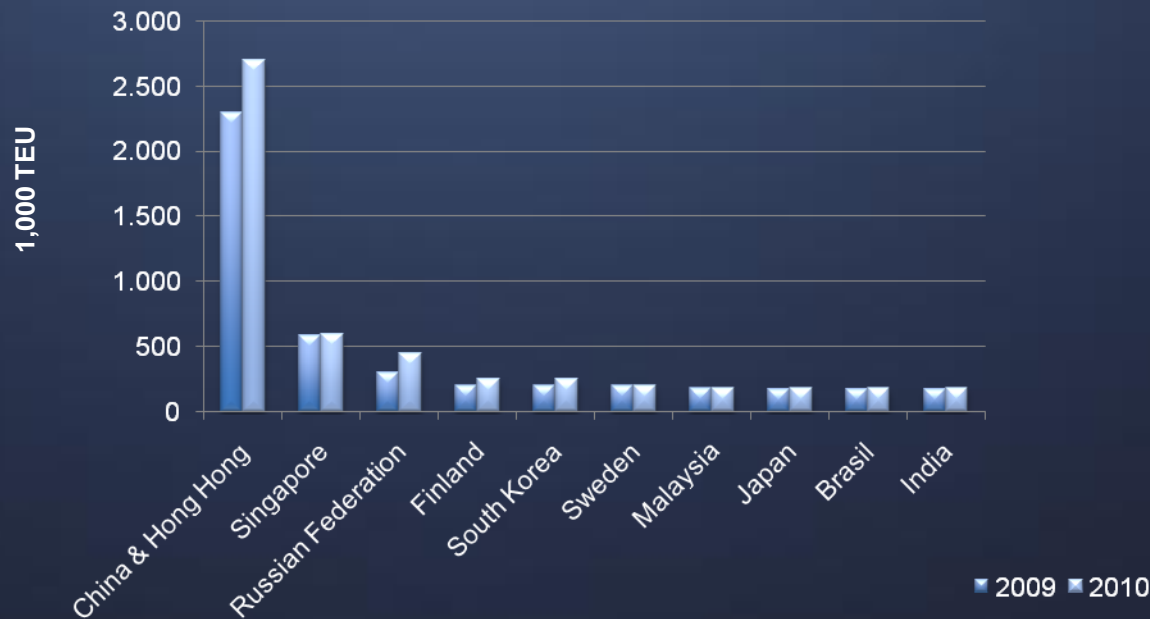
THE PORT OF HAMBURG IS ONE OF THE WORLD'S MOST IMPORTANT CARGO

- Record container handling: 7,9 million TEU (2010)
